Rev. Jones, a Social Studies teacher, is presently the pastor of the Canaan Baptist Church in Hempstead, and has long been involved in community service.


We especially appreciate Rev. Jones' devotion and hard work during our Junior year. Through his guidance and reassurance we were able to make it through some pretty impossible times!

Rev. Jones, this yearbook cannot begin to show the love and gratitude we feel, but we hope it's a start.






We the Co-Editors of the 1979 Colonial wish to thank the people who have helped us through our year of many troubles.
